


Day 1 - Maths

We have been working on making the numbers 1-20. Can you practise making these numbers in lots of different ways? For example, you could collect objects and arrange them, draw dice patterns or even use your fingers to show a different way of making the numbers!



Day 2

We have been identifying the different 2D shapes in our classroom. Can you complete a shape hunt around your house? Can you describe the shapes features using the vocabulary of sides, corners, straight and curved?



Day 3

Look at the maths talk picture below and count the different objects you can see! We have been using the sentence "I can see..." e.g "I can see four beds." Ask your child if they can represent what they can see using their fingers e.g "My four fingers represent the four beds." Maybe you can spot the different shapes in the picture too!




Day 4
